At the close of the public hearing on the FY2024-2025 Proposed Budget, the Board will meet in a work session to hear the Chavez Huerta K-12 Preparatory Academy (CHPA) Annual Follow Up Report, FY2024-2025 Consolidated Programs Application Report, Roncalli Closure Update, Negotiations Update, and FY 2024-2025 Proposed Budget Update.

Following the work session, the Board will be asked to approve various board policies related to the updated regulations for Title IX released by the US Department of Education and approve the Consent Agenda. The Board will also be asked to approve the Superintendent's recommendation for administrative leadership appointments/reassignments.
